- ✓ Organization of four local deliberative events for identification of key citizens' priorities;
- ✓ Preparing of Discussion Summary on the identified citizen priorities in the local deliberative events;
- ✓ Preparation of a policy brief with specific policy recommendations to the key democratic priorities in the country;
- ✓ Organising the deliberative polling;
- ✓ Public policy advocacy of the findings.
