EDUCATIONAL POLICIES



Educational programs to improve the understanding of the negative potential of social media for young people, parents and teachers.



Also trainings for institutions to equip their staff with digital and media literacy skills for national and EU intuitions. CSOs and journalists.

MENTAL HEALTH ISSUES AND ADEQUATE POLICIES



Internet addiction should be addressed with adequate educational programs, by stimulating public discussion on this topic and by engaging young people in creative offline projects.

These conclusions and recommendations are based on the findings from the youth consultation event designed to understand the youth personal experiences on the internet, both positive or negative, and their opinions on what policy actions and which stakeholders should be implementing these actions to improve the users experience.
