The project “Fostering public participation in constructive political dialogue” aims to strengthen informed public debate in North Macedonia by engaging citizens and Members of Parliament (MPs) in inclusive, deliberative dialogues on political polarization. Building on previous deliberative polling initiatives with Stanford University, the project promotes citizen participation in shaping democratic reform.

- Raise awareness of the value of deliberation among stakeholders.

- Conduct an analysis on democracy and polarization with input from MPs;
- Organize a national deliberative polling event;
- Produce a policy brief with actionable recommendations;
- Hold advocacy meetings and organize three policy dialogues with the Assembly working bodies;
- Promote activities via press and public briefings.
