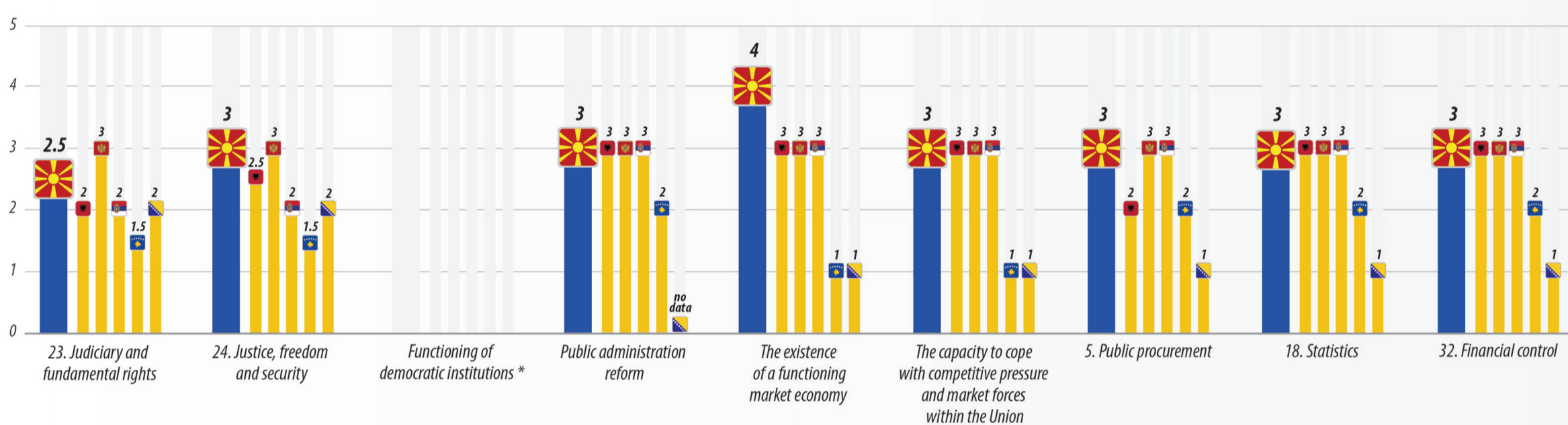
Clusters of negotiating chapters

Grading of the level of preparedness as per EC reports:

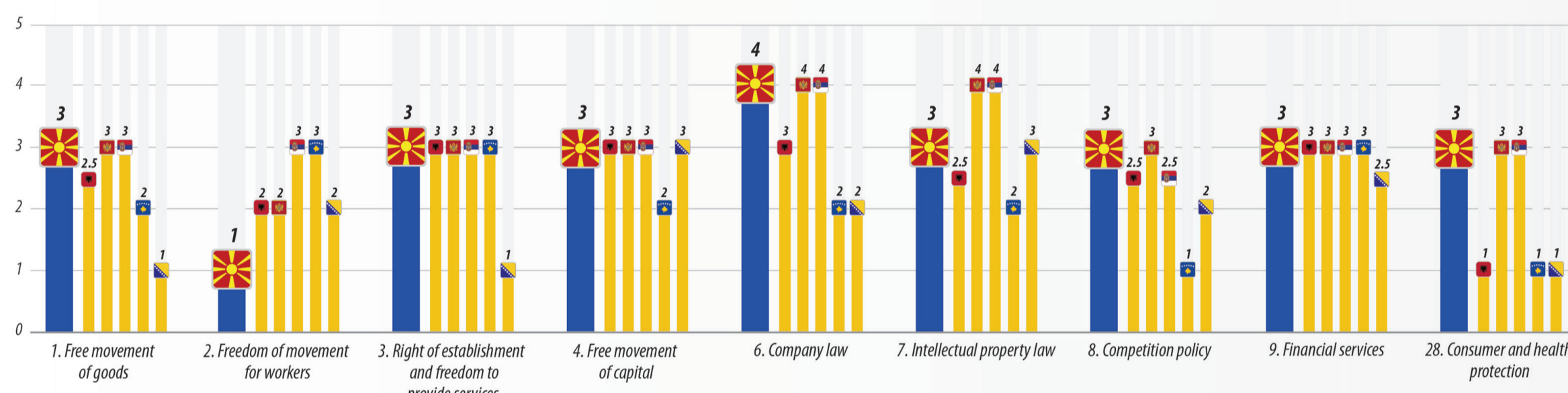
1- At an early stage, 2- Some level of preparation; 3- Moderately prepared; 4- Good level of preparation, 5- Well advanced

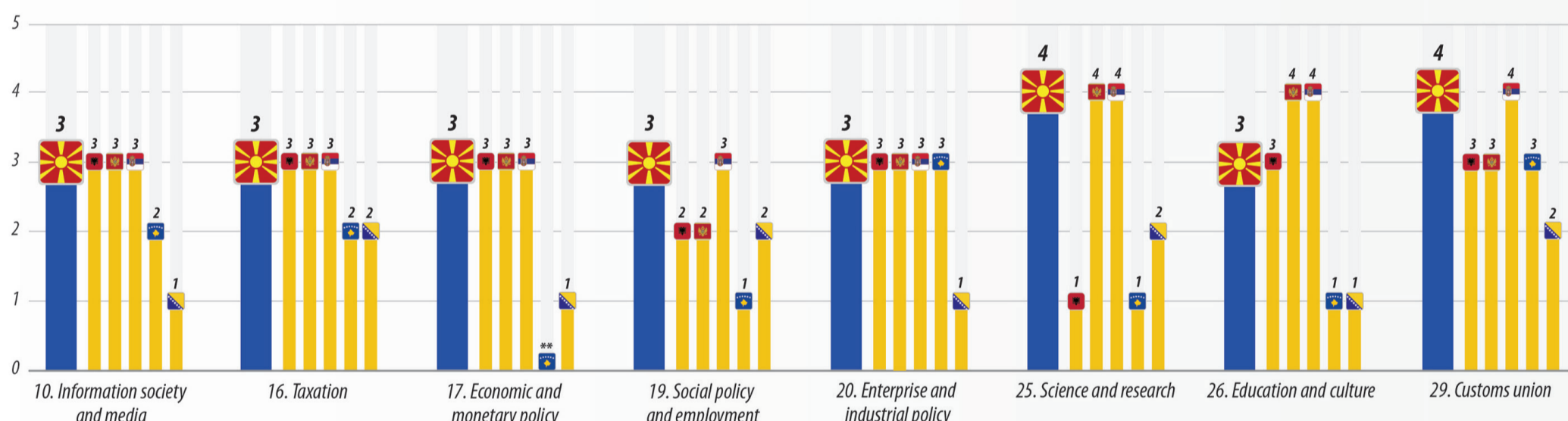

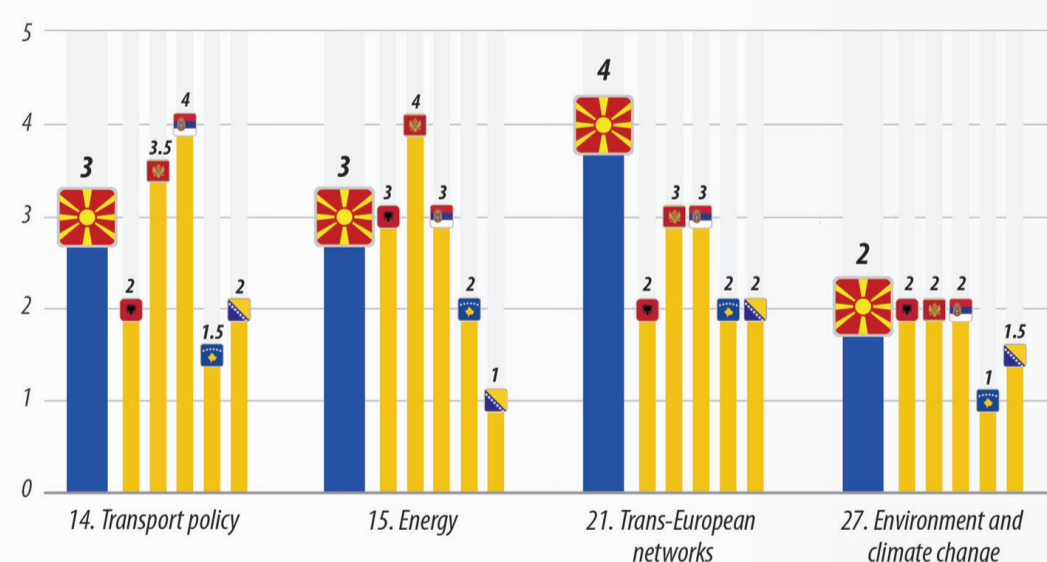

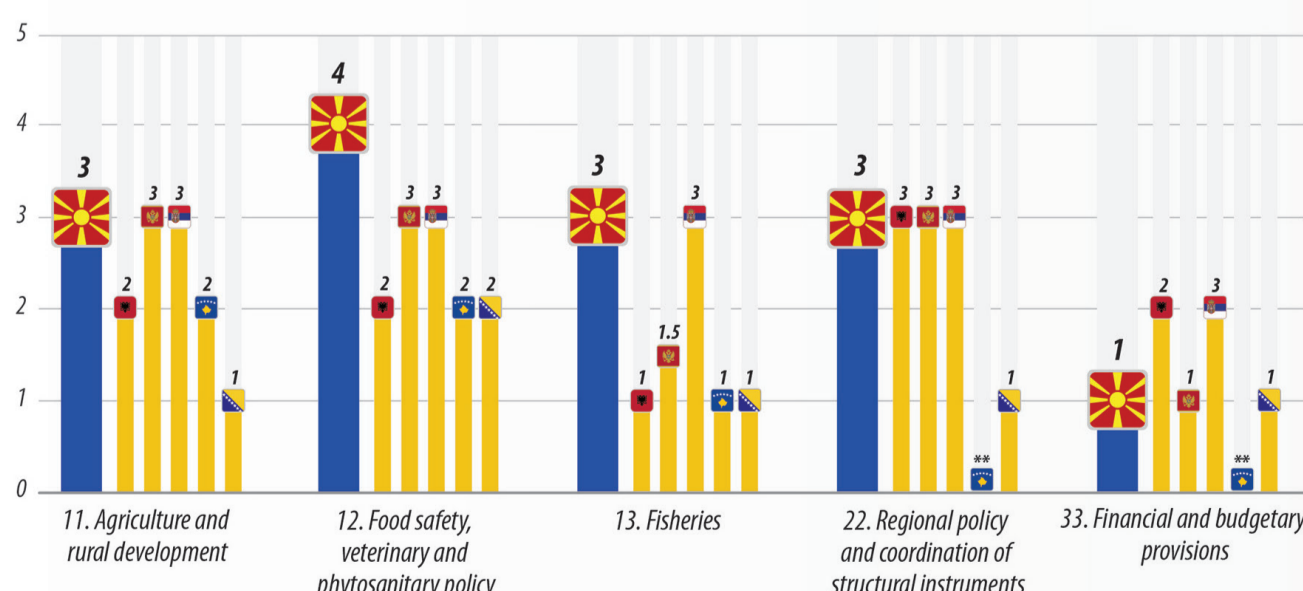

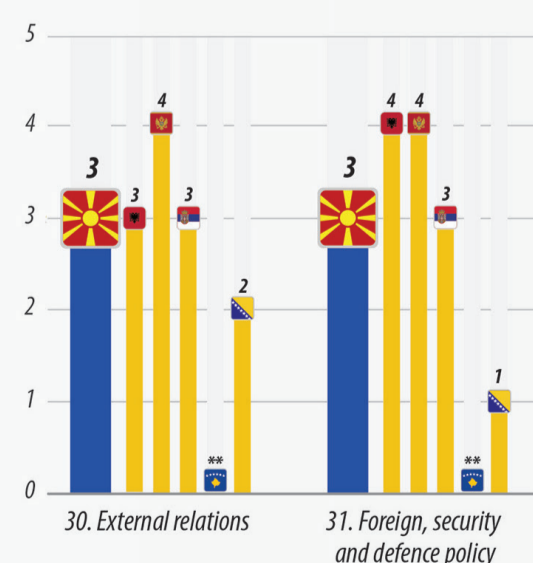
