Key Findings:



Full procedural compliance maintained

Legal and institutional RGF requirements completed on time



Transparency gaps persist

Key reports and supporting documents not publicly available



Loan-based disbursement

Released funds have been disbursed through loans to the national authority, with no disbursements yet made through WBIF or the grant component.



Limited step achievement

Only 6/21 reform steps fully achieved according to the EC's assesment



Legislative progress outpaces implementation

Legal alignment advancing faster than operational reforms



Reforms in grace periods

Delays threaten timing and predictability of future funding

Key Recommendations:



Operationalise RGF monitoring platform

Ensure functional and publicly accessible tracking system



Prioritise reforms under grace periods

Reduce risks to future performance-based disbursements



Improve transparency of implementation

Publish payment requests, reports, and supporting data



Strengthen institutional capacity

Address staffing gaps and operational readiness of institutions



Strengthen CSO participation

Ensure clear and meaningful involvement in monitoring
